ADDENDUM NO.1

to

FRAMEWORK BUSINESS PLAN

for the

ENVIRONMENTAL CO-OPERATION PROGRAMME

between

THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA

and

THE KINGDOM OF NORWAY

for the period

1 JULY 2005 TO 31 MARCH 2010

WHEREAS the Government of the Kingdom of Norway ("Norway") and the Government of the Republic of South Africa ("South Africa") have agreed on a Framework Business Plan regarding the Environment Co-operation between South Africa and Norway from 2005 to 2010 ("the Programme") dated 13 December 2005.

WHEREAS Norway and South Africa have decided to revise the procedures for approval of individual sub-projects under the Programme.

NOW THEREFORE Norway and South Africa have reached the following understanding which shall constitute Addendum No. 1 ("Addendum No 1") to the Framework Business Plan regarding the Environment Co-operation between South Africa and Norway from 2005 to 2010:

Article 1

1. The Programme will be initiated and managed by the DEAT in Pretoria and individual sub-projects will be located as defined in the detailed Project Business Plans to be entered into between DEAT and the implementing institutions. The Project Business Plans, and any subsequent amendments, shall be submitted to Norway for comments, before signing and entering into force.
2. Paragraph 2.2 of the Framework Business Plan shall read: "The Programme will be initiated and managed by the DEAT in Pretoria and individual sub-projects will be located as defined in the detailed Project Business Plans to be entered into between DEAT and the implementing institutions. The Project Business Plans, and any subsequent amendments, shall be submitted to NEP for information and possible comments before approval by DEAT."

Article 2

1. This addendum shall enter into force on the date of its signature and shall remain in force until both Parties have fulfilled all obligations arising from it. Whether these obligations shall be regarded as fulfilled shall be determined in consultation between the Parties.

2. Notwithstanding the previous paragraph both Parties may terminate the present Addendum by giving three months written notice to the other Party.
